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11. *Chlorophyll a* (Chl *a*) is the primary photosynthetic pigment in most plants and algae. It is a green pigment that absorbs light energy and converts it into chemical energy. Chl *a* is found in the chloroplasts of plants and in the thylakoids of algae. It is a central component of the photosynthetic reaction center, where it plays a key role in the light-dependent reactions of photosynthesis. Chl *a* is also involved in the regulation of photosynthesis and in the protection of the photosynthetic apparatus from damage by reactive oxygen species.
